Day 1: Fly to Seattle, Vancouver. Home pickup delivers you to the airport for our flight to Seattle. A charter motorcoach then takes us over the border to Vancouver, British Columbia for a get-acquainted dinner and the night. (D)

Day 2: Vancouver, Coral Princess. After breakfast we tour Vancouver. Highlights include historic Gastown, Stanley Park with its totems, and Canada Place where we board Princess Cruises' *Coral Princess* sailing for adventure in Alaska. (B,D)

Days 3-5: Inside Passage Cruising. Cruising the sheltered waters of the Inside Passage, the *Coral Princess* calls at Ketchikan and Juneau, Alaska's capital, where an optional tour goes to Mendenhall Glacier. (All meals included aboard ship.)

Day 6: Skagway. Famed as the "Gateway to the Yukon" during the 1898 Klondike Gold rush, Skagway and its original historic buildings are yours to explore today. Optional excursions are available including the thrilling ride on the White Pass & Yukon Route Railway.

Days 7-8: Glacier Cruising. Alaskan waterways reveal more glaciers than anywhere else on earth. Onboard naturalists and enrichment classes explain the geology as we cruise Glacier Bay National Monument and College Fjord. (All meals included aboard ship.)

Day 9: McKinley Express. On arrival at Whittier, Alaska, step off the ship and onto the *McKinley Express*, the Princess Tours train for the six hour trip inland to Talkeetna. Ride upstairs in the panorama-domed railcars, or snap pictures from the open-air platforms downstairs. Overnight is at the Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge. (B)

Day 10: Talkeetna, Denali. After a morning at leisure, we again board the train for the four-hour trip to Denali National Park. The railroad food service areas sell freshly prepared meals. Tonight is our first of two at the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge.

Day 11: Denali National Park. Today's motorcoach tour into the tundra lets us look for wildlife and, weather permitting, the 20,300-foot summit of Mt. McKinley, North America's highest.

Days 12-14: Fairbanks. After a free morning, we reboard the private Princess railcars and ride four hours to Fairbanks, only 90 miles from the Arctic Circle, for two nights. Our day of exploring this gold rush boomtown includes the El Dorado Gold Mine and a cruise on the Cheena and Tanana rivers aboard the sternwheeler *Discovery*. It's up and out early on our final day for connecting flights back to Chicago and return transfers home.

Day 1: Lakeshore Limited. Our tour starts with home pickup and transfer to Chicago Union Station for the late evening departure of Amtrak's eastbound *Lakeshore Limited*. Settle into your reclining coach seat* for the overnight ride.

Day 2: Mohawk River Valley, Berkshires, Springfield, MA. The train's diner/lounge is open and selling breakfast and lunch as we ride down the Mohawk River Valley. After passing through the scenic Berkshire Mountains, the train arrives Springfield, Massachusetts, where we transfer to the Sheraton Hotel.

Day 3: Mystic Seaport, Shoreline Trolley, Yale. Breakfast is included before we head to the Connecticut shore of Long Island Sound. At Mystic Seaport, stroll back in time to a town of the mid-1800's...17 acres of historic houses, shops and seaport buildings. Board the *Charles W. Morgan*, last of the wooden whaling ships. Next stop is a rolling museum, the Shoreline Trolley at East Haven, for an electric trolley ride. Final stop is the campus of Yale University, in New Haven since 1716. Dinner and the night are on the Connecticut coast. (B,D)

Day 4: New York City, Carnival Triumph. After breakfast, we ride into New York City. A local guide joins us for a narrated tour of the Big Apple, ending at the pier to board *Carnival Triumph*. Our cabins are Ocean View, each with two lower beds, window, bathroom, color TV and shower. Watch the Manhattan skyline slip away as we sail under the Verrazano Bridge into the Atlantic. (CB,D)

Days 5-8: Carnival Triumph Cruising, Canadian Ports. After a full day at sea, we call at St. John, New Brunswick. Optional shore excursions here include Reversing Falls where the powerful Bay of Fundy tides force the river waters back upstream. Next day's port is Halifax, Nova Scotia. Tour the Citadel National Historic Park or shop for Canadian goods at bargain prices. Shore excursions take you down the coast to picturesque Peggy's Cove or to the *Titanic* treasures and cemetery. A final day at sea is more time for ship-board fun. (All meals included aboard ship.)



Days 9-10: South Street Seaport, Lakeshore Limited. Be up early to see the Statue of Liberty. After disembarking, we visit historic South Street Seaport on the East River. At Penn Station we board the westbound *Lakeshore Limited* for the 19-hour ride to Chicago and transfers home. (B)
