Day 1: Kettle Moraine State Forest, Old Wade House. This morning after home pickup, we depart for America's Dairyland, Wisconsin! First stop is the delightful Cedar Creek Settlement at Cedarburg, founded in 1864. Here we have time to explore the different shops and antique stores. A delicious lunch is included today. This afternoon we enjoy a scenic drive through the Kettle Moraine State Forest. At the old Wade House, we experience a horse-drawn carriage ride at this one time stagecoach stop on the plank road between Fond du Lac and Sheboygan. Our lodging for the next two nights is at the lovely Ramada Plaza Hotel in Green Bay. Tonight, we enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel. (L,D)

Day 2: Door County, Fish Boil. A continental breakfast begins our day of touring the blazing fall colors of Door County, "the Cape Cod of the Midwest." Door County is a lovely peninsula stretching into Lake Michigan. A local guide boards our coach for a narrated tour of the spectacular scenery. We travel through the quaint villages of Ephraim, Ellison Bay, Baileys Harbor, and Sister Bay. Enjoy free time for shopping in Fish Creek, then tour the charming Bjorklunden Chapel and the Door County Peninsula Winery. Lunch is a traditional Door County fish boil! This evening, enjoy the hotel's indoor swimming pool, or take an optional shuttle to the nearby Oneida Casino. (CB,L)

Day 3: National Railroad Museum, East Troy Trolley. After a continental breakfast in Green Bay, we visit the National Railroad Museum. Here we see a variety of rail exhibits including Eisenhower's World War II command train and the world's largest steam locomotive. Enjoy a picnic lunch at the Museum before heading south. On our return home, we make a special stop at the East Troy Electric Railroad Museum for a trolley ride to the famous Elegant Farmer, a colorful market known for its apple pie baked in a bag. Return transfers take us home from the motorcoach this evening. (CB,L)

Day 1: Beautiful Ontario, Canada. Following pickup at home, board our deluxe motorcoach headed east. Lunch is included in Battle Creek, MI, before crossing the Ambassador Bridge into Canada's Ontario province. Overnight lodging is at the Best Western Lamplighter Inn at London, Ontario. We get together tonight for a get-acquainted dinner. (L,D)

Day 2: *Maid of the Mist*, IMAX Theatre. This is a day to long remember as we see three different views of a Natural Wonder of the World, Niagara Falls. After a short ride this morning we visit the Niagara Falls IMAX Theatre to "experience" a heart-pounding ride over the Falls. At Queen Victoria Park to see the Horseshoe Falls from the top. Finally, we board the legendary *Maid of the Mist* for the thrilling ride to the base of the thundering cascade. Unwind with an included dinner and spend two nights at the Best Western Cairn Croft Hotel, just a mile from the Falls. (D)

Day 3: Journey Behind The Falls, Niagara On The Lake. After seeing Niagara Falls from the park beside and the river below, we venture today into the cave behind the roaring waters! Don a raincoat for the walk through the tunnels to see and hear the back side of the Falls. We also see the Niagara River whitewaters, some of the wildest rapids in the world. At the Niagara River Whirlpool, we board an open-air gondola car for a ride over the swirling waters. This afternoon we visit the quaint town of Niagara On The Lake and a local winery. Tonight, enjoy a mouth-watering prime rib of beef dinner at the Skylon Tower Revolving Restaurant. The Tower soars up 520 feet and offers breathtaking views of the Falls. (B,D)

Day 4: Butterfly Conservatory. Awake this morning to a delicious breakfast at the hotel before we visit the Butterfly Conservatory on the grounds of the Niagara Falls Botanical Gardens. See over 200 live, exotic butterfly species in a tropical rainforest setting. This afternoon we travel to Chatham, Ontario, for the evening and a farewell dinner at the Best Western Wheels Inn. (B,D)

Day 5: The Henry Ford. After breakfast at the hotel we cross back into the United States and on to Dearborn, MI. Here is "Henry Ford's attic," the amazing Henry Ford Museum. See the original Model-T, antique airplanes, a giant steam locomotive, Presidential limousines, and much more! Return home by shuttle from the motorcoach early this evening. (B)
