**Day 1: Wisconsin, Minnesota.** Transfers pick us up at home and take us to the motorcoach this morning, beginning our fun-filled tour to the Treasure Island Casino and Mall of America. Lunch is included today at Burnstad's European Cafe at Tomah is central Wisconsin. Leaving the interstate, we travel along the scenic Mississippi River before arriving at the Treasure Island Resort near Red Wing, MN. We spend three nights at this great resort where you can gamble or just relax. (L)

**Day 2: Treasure Island Resort, Casino.** Today is free to enjoy the activities and casino at Treasure Island. This indoor resort has tropical jungles, exotic beaches, cascading waterfalls and island villages. Our stay includes one free game at the new, 24-lane Island Xtreme Bowl. The big casino offers 2,500 slot and video poker machines as well as table games. With your Island Passport Club Card you get \$40.00 free slot play. Unwind and relax in the Resort's Emerald Bay Club, Toucan Harry's Sports Bar or the Parlay Lounge. An optional shuttle is available to the town of Red Wing for shopping or sightseeing. A buffet dinner is included tonight at the Tradewinds Restaurant. (D)

**Day 3: Mall of America.** We depart for Bloomington this morning and time at the famous Mall of America. This is the nation's largest retail and entertainment complex, featuring more than 500 specialty stores. For something different, buy a ticket for the mall's Underwater Adventures Aquarium and walk the glass tunnels through 1.2 million gallons of water, surrounded by more than 4,500 sea creatures. For lunch on your own there are dozens of restaurants and sports bars. Later in the day we return to the Treasure Island Resort where dinner is again included. (D)

**Day 4: Quivey's Grove Restaurant.** Breakfast is included this morning before departing Treasure Island. Along the way we stop for a home-cooked meal at historic Quivey's Grove Restaurant in Madison, Wisconsin's capital. After the motorcoach returns, we board shuttles for the return home. (B,L)

**Day 1: Kringles, Farm Market Kitchen.** Wisconsin makes more than cheese! See what else is made where and how on this unique tour that begins with home pickup. First stop is the O & H Danish Bakery in Racine to sample and buy Danish kringles, light pastry layers with fruit or nut fillings. Next is a hearty German lunch with entertainment at the Bavarian Inn Restaurant in Glendale. As a farm incubator hatches eggs, the Farm Market Kitchen in Algoma, hatches food-related small business ideas. This shared use commercial kitchen allows local growers, chefs, and restaurants to test new recipes and technologies. Our visit includes a production demonstration and shopping time at the store. Our day ends at The Four Seasons Resort on Miscoano Island in the Menominee River. Being smaller and younger than the M-island hotel in Michigan, The Four Seasons calls itself "The Baby Grand Hotel," a fabulous northwoods resort. Here amid the amenities we spend the next two nights. Dinner this evening is complete with stories of its 1905 founding and gangster hideout days. (L,D)

**Day 2: Iron Mountain Mine, Four Seasons Resort.** After a deluxe continental breakfast, our sightseeing takes us across the Menominee River into Michigan. At the Iron Mountain Iron Mine and Museum we don hard hats and raincoats to learn of this product of the underground. Hear stories of miners and mines as we ride a tram through the tunnels to the museum. Back in the light, we enjoy a miners lunch at the Pine Mountain Hotel and the views from Pine Mountain. Back at The Four Seasons, the afternoon and evening are free for resort activities, spa treatments and dinner on your own. (CB,L)

**Day 3: Saxon Dairy Farm, Kohler, Harley-Davidson.** Say farewell to The Four Seasons after a deluxe continental breakfast and ride south to the Saxon Homestead Farm and Creamery at Cleveland, WI. From pasture to store, learn the story of cheese and this family dairy farm. Try samples and buy cheeses in the farm store. At Kohler we enjoy a great lunch of Wisconsin bratwurst sausages. At the Kohler Design Center we learn the history and see new designs of this plumbing product producer. Our final Wisconsin product is also an American icon, Harley-Davidson Motorcycles. Milwaukee's new Harley-Davidson Museum displays antique motorcycles, and tells the stories from a century of builders and riders. On returning to the Chicago area, transfers take us home from the motorcoach. (CB,L)
